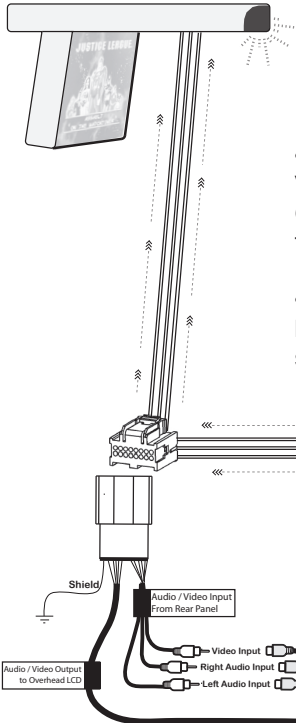


# GMLRSE

## Overhead LCD retention cable for GMLAN Full Size SUV's Rear Seat Entertainment (RSE)



**The GMLRSE is a plug and play cable that routes the audio and video signals to the Rear Seat Entertainment (RSE) LCD. The audio and video inputs located in the rear of the center console are also terminated as RCA jacks behind the radio at this connector.**

- **When using a headunit with source control (A/V inputs and A/V outputs)** - connect the cables labeled "Audio/Video input from Rear Panel" to an A/V input (i.e. A/V 1 in, A/V 2 in). The cables labeled "Audio Video output to Overhead LCD" will then connect to the A/V output of the new source unit. The single black wire is a shield, connect this to ground.
- **When using a standalone DVD player (only A/V outputs)** - In this case, connect the A/V outputs to the cables labeled "Audio/Video output to Overhead LCD". The rear panel A/V inputs will not be used and the black shield wire should be connected to ground.

**Note:** This cable is intended for use in conjunction with an GMAHLAN or GMAHLANB to retain all safety and convenience systems. The vehicle should be equipped with a Panasonic Overhead LCD and IR system, in which the DVD player was part of the AM/FM/CD receiver. The GMAHLAN or GMAHLANB is needed to power the IR headphone system.
